Questions and Responses

1. In the proposal, it states:

On-site: The proposed fee shall include the cost for the professional development/specialized training. If vendor is traveling from out of state, travel costs will be reimbursed on actual costs (flight, hotel, transportation, meals based on State of New Mexico per diem rates).

Local Offerors shall propose a fee that does not include travel costs (air fare, hotel, transportation, meals, etc.)

Will you please clarify the definition of "local"? Is this within Roswell City limits? Within New Mexico? Within 100 miles of Roswell?

Within Roswell City limits.

- 2. Are travel cost fees ONLY offered to vendors traveling from out of state? In a more specific example, if a vendor's coach is traveling to RISD from Albuquerque, should/could a travel cost fee be applied here?

- 3. How many students in currently participate in blended learning in RISD? No students.
