

Succeeds Act (ESSA) providing private schools the services needed to level the playing field for disadvantaged students.

FACTS Education Solutions will provide Title IA and Title IIA Services. Title IA services include: providing a Paraprofessional or Title I teacher and possible professional development to support teachers of Title I students. Title IIA services include: differentiated instruction, classroom discipline, engaging students in a remote learning environment, and other potential topics.

The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) provides private schools with federal funding to ensure success for students and teachers. The law helps "level the playing field" for disadvantaged students and requires that all students be taught to high academic standards that prepare them for success. Vendor shall have the ability to assess social, emotional, and behavioral needs of students and their impact on academic performance offering intervention that improves the academic achievement of students; be knowledgeable of State of NM Academic Standards; have the ability to provide instruction that is high quality, research-based, and specifically designed to increase academic achievement, especially in reading, writing, and/or mathematics; have the knowledge and awareness of local community needs; have the ability to provide outcome evaluation measures; and provide necessary/relevant professional development.

V. Provide a detailed, sufficient explanation of the reasons, qualifications, proprietary rights or unique capabilities of the prospective contractor that makes the prospective contractor the one source capable of providing the required professional service, service, construction or item(s) of tangible personal property. FACTS Education Solutions works to elevate the education experience through professional development and teacher/student growth. They have experience with the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) and proven results in improving academic outcomes for students through supplemental instruction and research-based professional development. Their unique capability is that they have worked with each of the two schools for the past two years forming a relationship and providing services that no other vendor could come in and immediately duplicate and continue providing.

VI. Provide a detailed, sufficient explanation of how the professional service, service, construction or item(s) of tangible personal property is/are unique and how this uniqueness is substantially related to the intended purpose of the contract.

The services, themselves, are not unique. The uniqueness comes from the two year relationship that FACTS Education Solutions has with each school. After seeing the impact and progress that the vendor has helped the school make over the past two years, the administrators feel it is best for the continuity and consistency of working with FACTS Education Solutions to remain in place. Another vendor could not step in and continue where FACTS Education Solutions left off, resulting in the use of funding and time to bring the new vendor up to speed.

VII. Explain why other similar professional services, services, construction or item(s) of tangible personal property *cannot* meet the intended purpose of the contract.

FACTS Education Solutions and each school has a two year investment in one another. No other vendor could step in and continue what FACTS Education Solutions has set in place. It would take a lot of time and the use of federal funding for a new vendor to understand the schools' unique needs (which FACTS Education Solutions currently does) and maintain the continuity of services that FACTS Education Solutions has provided.
