April 1 Deadline

The deadline is April 1 for interested individuals to apply for an online, two-term program to earn an alternative teaching licensure certificate in Career Technical Education.



16-hour credit program through CNMCC

The 16-credit-hour program through Central New Mexico Community College aligns with guidelines for the New Mexico Secondary



Technical-Vocational Education teaching license, grades 7-12. The program is designed for individuals with occupational/industry experience who are interested in a teaching career.

Program begins in May; completes in April 2022

Students will begin the program in May and complete it by April 2022.

Participants are eligible to work as CTE teachers while completing the program. All applicants will receive support for filling out applications for grants and scholarships. Once accepted, individuals are eligible to apply for a Secondary Technical Vocational License.
