Vocabulary

- * mistakes: It is Ok to make mistakes. You are the artist, you get to decide what it will look like.
- * Arts Integration Expectations

Lesson / Instruction / Narrative

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Intro:

- * Introduce myself.
- * Introduce Arts Integration and the expectations for class.
- * Vocabulary: mistakes - "It is okay to make mistakes. It is okay to mess up." Discuss how we learn by making mistakes.

Book:

- * Read: The Giving Tree by Shel Silverstein grades 3-5, Our Class is a Family grades K-2

Lesson:

- * Show artists a sample of a place card. Explain what they are used for.
- * Tell artists that as they are working, you will be going around the room taking their picture with a Polaroid Camera.
- * Show how the cameras work - take a group picture if possible.
- * Introduce Model Magic - how it is used, what it can be used for, how to mix it, etc.
- * Explain to artists that they will be working on their own, at their desk to create their sculpture.
- * Tell artists that when they are finished, you will give them the twisty wire to put their picture in the place card and display it on the desk.
- * Tell artists that if they finish early, they can ask for some paper to draw on while the others are working.

Closing:

- * Do a gallery walk.
- * What did you think of the Polaroid pictures?
- * What did you think of the Model Magic?
- * Explain to artists that you will return in 2 weeks with a new lesson!
