Job Title: CERTIFIED OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSISTANT (COTA)

Reports To: ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT FOR SPECIAL SERVICES

General Job Description:

To assist the Occupational Therapist in implementing the individual educational plan (IEP) for students.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Work cooperatively with colleagues, supervisors, and administrators.
- 2. Demonstrate ethical behavior.
- **3.** Engage in self-development.
- **4.** Follow district policies and administrative rules and regulations.
- **5.** Maintain behavior appropriate to performing and accomplishing assigned duties.
- **6.** Know what to do to successfully complete assigned work.
- 7. Project over-all concern for personal appearance as it relates to job performance.
- 8. Assist in the rapeutic services aimed at enhancing the student's potential for learning.
- **9.** Assist students in acquiring the functional performance skills needed to participate in the education environment.
- 10. Help students function independently.
- **11.** The COTA will assist in assessment, screening, evaluations, reassessment, treatment activities, and documentation following initial direction of the OTR.
- 12. Assist the Occupational Therapist in implementing the Individual Educational Plan (IEP) for students.
- 13. Staff will have 10 business days from the completion of service to enter their Medicaid notes as supervised by the OTR.
- **14.** Maintain confidentiality with sensitive matters.
- 15. Be flexible and able to prioritize tasks and maintain accurate and detailed records.
- **16.** Communicate in well-organized oral and written forms.
- 17. Report to work on time and work no less than 7.25 hours per day.
- **18.** Work independently with very little supervision, per NM Licensing & Regulatory Board and discretion of supervising Occupational Therapist.
- 19. Other tasks as may be deemed appropriate and necessary by your immediate supervisor.

Qualifications:

- 1. High School diploma or GED
- 2. The completion of a planned program through an accredited institution.
- 3. Current NM Licensure per State of NM Licensing & Regulatory Board.
- **4.** Valid Driver's license and Car Insurance
- 5. Must obtain a minimum of 2.0 CEUs or 20 Contract hours per year to meet Licensure requirements.

Physical Requirements:

Sitting, standing, lifting and carrying (up to 40 pounds), climbing stairs, reaching, squatting, kneeling, having full mobility of fingers/hands, and moving light furniture may be required, unless ADA accommodations have been mutually agreed on and does not create an undue hardship upon the district.

Safety and Health:

Knowledge of universal hygiene precautions (blood borne pathogens, body fluids, etc.)

Equipment/Material Handled:

Must know how to properly operate, or be willing to learn to operate, multi-media equipment including current technology as needed.
